## PICTORIAL PHOTOGRAPHY

Perceiving changes in the arts is always difficult when viewed from a one year to the next basis. It's like the visitor to the seashore who's watching the water's level to determine the direction of the tide. He sees ripples and wavelets creeping up and down the sands, but only by lengthy watching can he observe the tide's movement. The Pictorial Salon visitor, within a single year, perceives nothing but minor and insignificant movements. The general trend is only evident after the passage of many years. What is happening in pictorial photography is scarcely clear. This year's special show focuses on the "what's happening" problem with a look at the pictorial prints of the past.

After its public announcement in 1839, photography was to be a medium for reporting and recording objects, people, and places. As this medium became better developed, picture making became more concerned with the purely aesthetic factors of line, mass, color, and value. By the mid 1890's "Pictorialism" began to grow into an international movement. Some pictorialists began to work with the manipulative and coloristic techniques of gum-bichromate and platinum printing. By the turn of the century, the multiple gum-print had become one of the most important printing processes for the pictorialists. Other photographers utilized soft focus and high keyed tonalities to de-emphasize details. Manipulation reached its Zenith during the 1920's and early '30's with the refinement and popularization of the Bromoil, carbon Fresson, and Carbro processes.

This year's special show contains but a small sample of pictorial photography from the first half of the 20th Century. Also on display are several of the cameras used by the pictorialist and hobbyist of yesteryear. The bulk and complexity of these cameras makes the achievements of the pictorialist even more impressive.

Among the dozen Bromoils in this show are a few of the many landscapes done by Chas. K. Archer and a Bromoil by Leonard Misonne, a past-master of the scenic genre. The multiple gum process is illustrated by F. O. Libby's winter view of Pittsburgh, "Floating Ice". Four carbon Fresson prints by J. Ortiz Echague show the capacity of this now obsolete manipulative process in the hands of an expert. In addition to examples of the seldom practiced palladium, platinum, and carbon processes there are many Bromide prints showing the range of subjects explored in the '20's, '30's, and '40's. Pittsburgh being an industrial city, it was natural that Pittsburghers Byron Chatto, O. C. Reiter, O. E. Romig, and P. F. Squire would produce many fine pictorial prints of industrial scenes. Studies of the human figure are also shown in the works of Z. Herczegh.
